## **Application for Street Entertainment License**

Baltimore City Board of Street Entertainment licenses street entertainers to perform in public spaces in Baltimore City, except for Harborplace, which provides its own Street Entertainers program. Street entertainer means any person who alone or as part of a group performs on the streets and solicits, encourages or accepts donations before, during or after the performance. Street entertainers include: musician, juggler, mime, puppeteer, unicyclist, clown, magician, sword swallower, dancer, poet, performance artist or comedian. A non-refundable application fee of \$25 in the form of a check or money order made out to Director of Finance must accompany the completed application and be submitted to the Miscellaneous Tax and License Unit, 200 N. Holliday Street, Baltimore, MD 21202 by July 24, 2006. Applicants may be asked to meet with representatives from the Board of Licenses prior to issuance of the license, to send audition tapes and performance information, and /or attend a Street Entertainers Showcase.
