

Fire and Life Safety Guidelines/Checklist

This checklist is provided to assist residents to comply with mandated life safety codes by Maryland State Housing and Fire Safety Offices. The Peabody Institute is required to support these expectations to protect our students and community and thus have developed policies and procedures to comply with state expectations.

This listing represents the most recent detailing of property and behaviors restricted under these codes, recognizing that it is impossible to list every possible item and situation and that expectations will change with time and experience. Please fix any indicated issues and/or remove any non-approved items by ______. Items left after this date will be removed from the room.

Non-approved items:

	eorge Foreman grills or similar cooking appliances pasters, toaster ovens, smokeless indoor grills, etc.
	otplates, electric skillets, crock pots, hot pots, electric tea kettle without automatic shut-off, etc.
	offee Pots without automatic shut-off
	icrowaves
	efrigerators over 4 cu. Ft.
	r Conditioners & All portable heating devices (space heaters of any kind). This includes electric blankets.
	alogen Lamps or Sun Lamps
Pl	astic or paper shade decorative lamps
C	andles, lanterns, incense, or anything else that produces an open flame
	ookahs (decorative or otherwise), water pipes, vaporizers, bowls, bongs, or other smoking paraphernalia
D	ecorative string lights (cannot be near curtains or hanging from ceiling)
A	l combustible materials (gas, lighter fluid, charcoal, propane, solvents, etc.)
A.	l items powered by combustible fuels (such as motorcycles)
	l fireworks, explosives, etc.
A	l corrosive (or poisonous) chemicals and hazardous materials
M	ultiple power strips connected together ("chaining")
	ire across floors that are not held down by a carpet or tape
Cı	artain/drapes and anything covering ceilings (tapestries, banners, posters, or other flammable materials)
W	all decorations covering more than 50% of the walls (tapestries, banners, posters, or other flammable materials)
	l tapestries or cloth decorations must be clearly labeled "Flame resistant"
	repe paper, plastic or Mylar decorations, ribbons, streamers, etc. hanging from light fixtures or ceiling
	ood lying open on desks, floors, etc.
