Notes:

It is not necessary to take every exam and sub-level. Students who enter the program at later stages in their development will start at the most appropriate level in the sequence. Also, it is not required to take partial exams. Complete exams covering the materials on both the first and second partial are permitted.

Certificates and mini-certificates are awarded only if exams are passed with a minimum of 80% and theory classes passed with a Grade of B-. Grade Reports and mini-certificates are mailed to students within 2 weeks of the exam.
