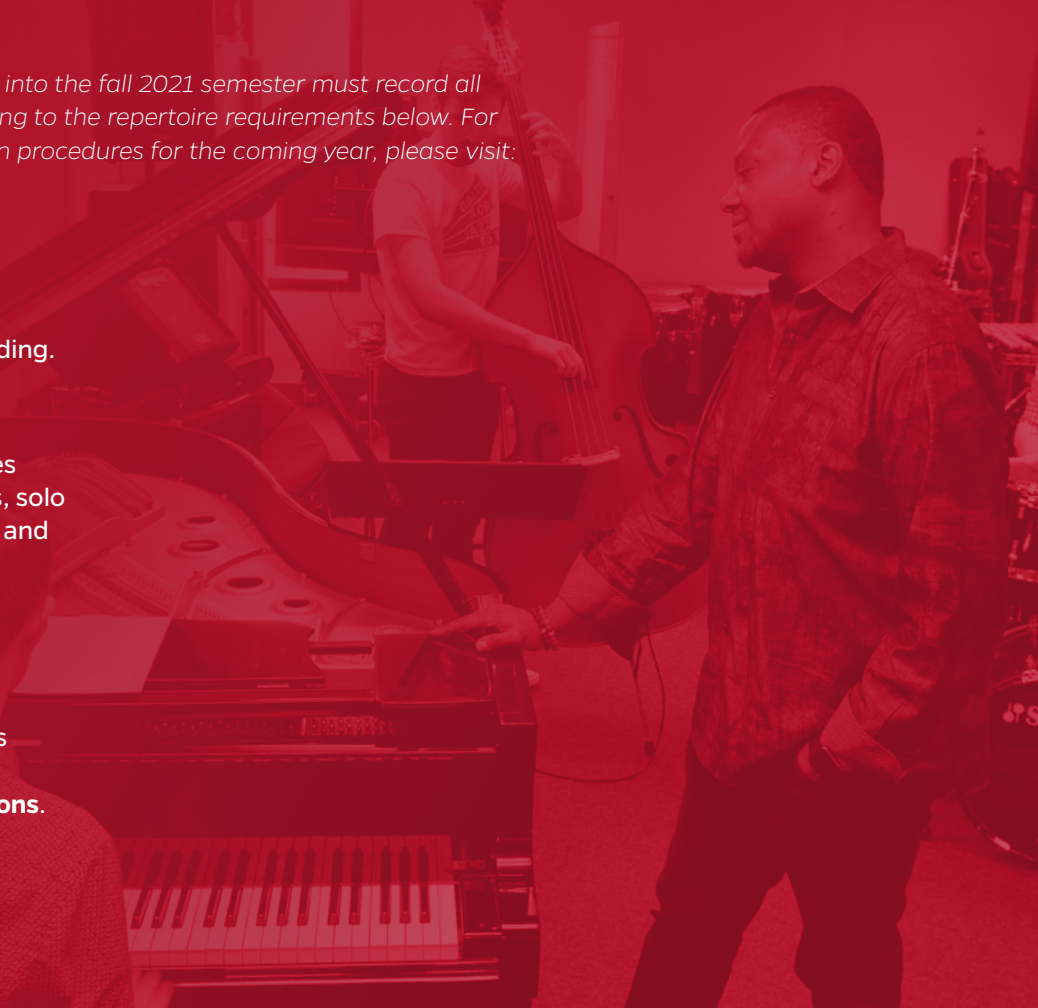
UNDERGRADUATE

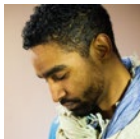

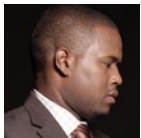
