Dress is casual concert attire:

### **What to Wear**

Flat/low heeled dress shoes

Flat/low heeled dress sandals

Skirts/dresses at **knee length or lower**

Dress slacks, khakis

Dress shirts or blouses

(tie not necessary; collar not necessary if the shirt is semi-formal )

### **What *NOT* to Wear**

Jeans

Shorts, Sweat pants

Flip flops, high heels, athletic shoes

T-shirts; shirts with writing

Shirts that are too high or too low

Short skirts
